This election is about a choice — between continuing a path where the wealth of the many is siphoned by the few, or charting a new course where prosperity is shared fairly, and every Guyanese rises together.

My friends, this is not just politics. This is about our future. About the Guyana we want our children to inherit. I ask for your trust, your faith, and your vote. Together, let us build a Guyana where opportunity is not a privilege but a right.

Better must come. And together, we will make it so. May God bless you, and may God bless our beautiful nation.

FIRST 100 DAYS IN GOVERNMENT

IMMEDIATE RELIEF FOR CITIZENS

- 18% salary increase for all Public Servants and Disciplined Services (retroactive to Sept 1, 2025).
- \$100,000 cash grant for every adult citizen (18+).
- \$75,000 per school child each term, free transportation to school, free uniforms + free school meals.
- Old age pension increased to \$100,000 per month.
- \$150,000 per month for persons living with disabilities.
- \$100,000 per month public assistance for ages 18–64.
- Raise income tax threshold no tax on earnings \$250,000 or less.
- Construct 200 homes (Sept-Dec 2025) for needy families.
- Reforming Governance
- Legislation to transfer a share of oil revenues directly to citizens.
- Begin renegotiation of the ExxonMobil oil contract.
- Table legislation to reform GECOM for free and fair elections.
- Reduce maximum police detention without charge to 24 hours.
- Confirm Chancellor and Chief Justice, ending 20-year stalemate.
- Amend Constitution to allow the Regional Judicial and Legal Services Commission to identify the Chancellor and Chief Justice in the event of a disagreement between the President and the Leader of the Opposition.
- Re-establish Constitutional Reform Committee with 2-year deadline.
- Introduce legislation to permit post election coalitions.
- Building Partnerships
- Negotiate multi-year wage agreements with unions for teachers, nurses, and other workers.
- Partner with the Mayor and City Council to restore Georgetown as the "Garden City of the Caribbean."
- Remove duties on 4x4 pickups to reduce costs for farmers, businesses, and workers.

- Legislate Cash Grants so that they are timely and not subjected to politician interference.
