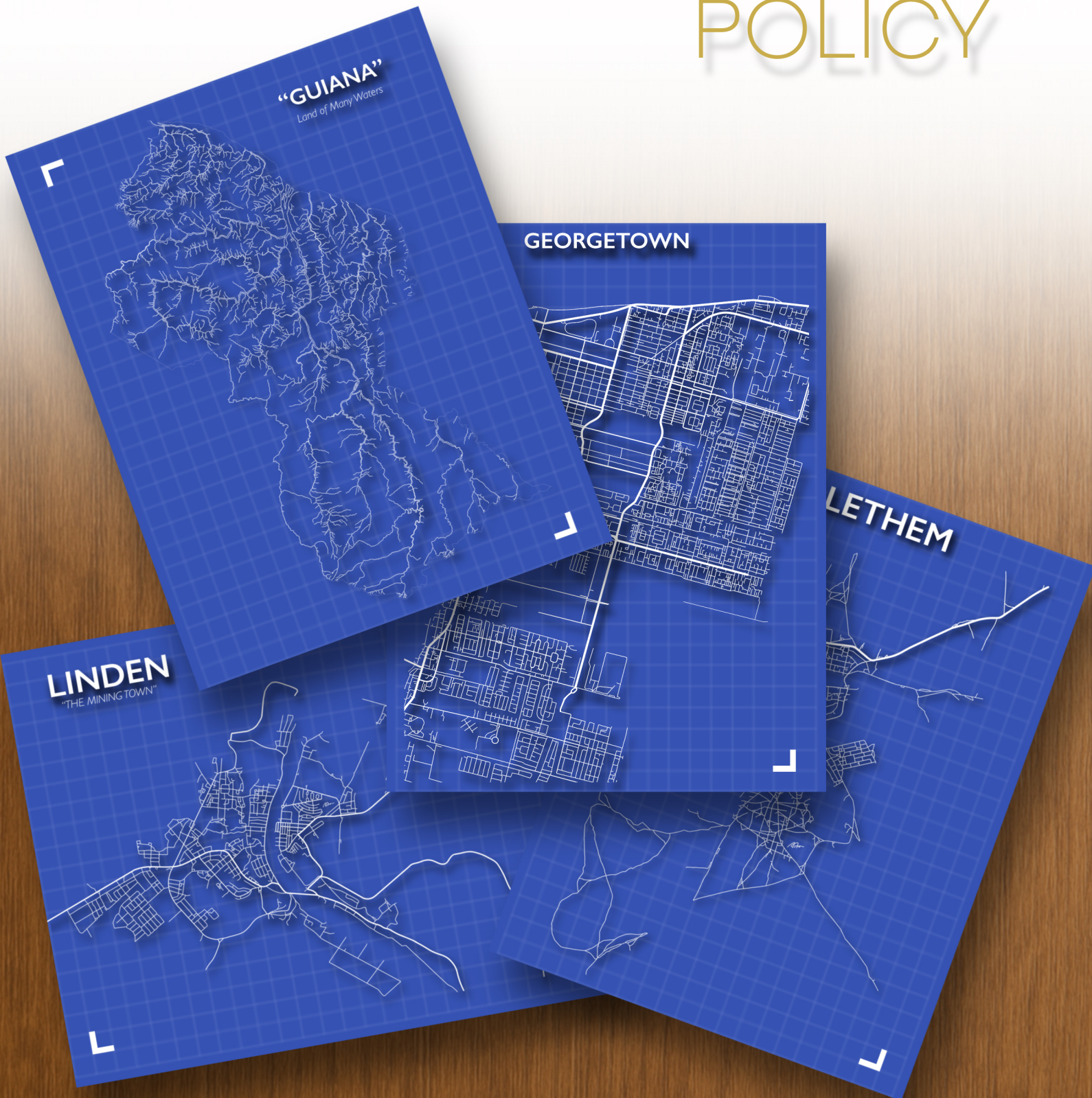

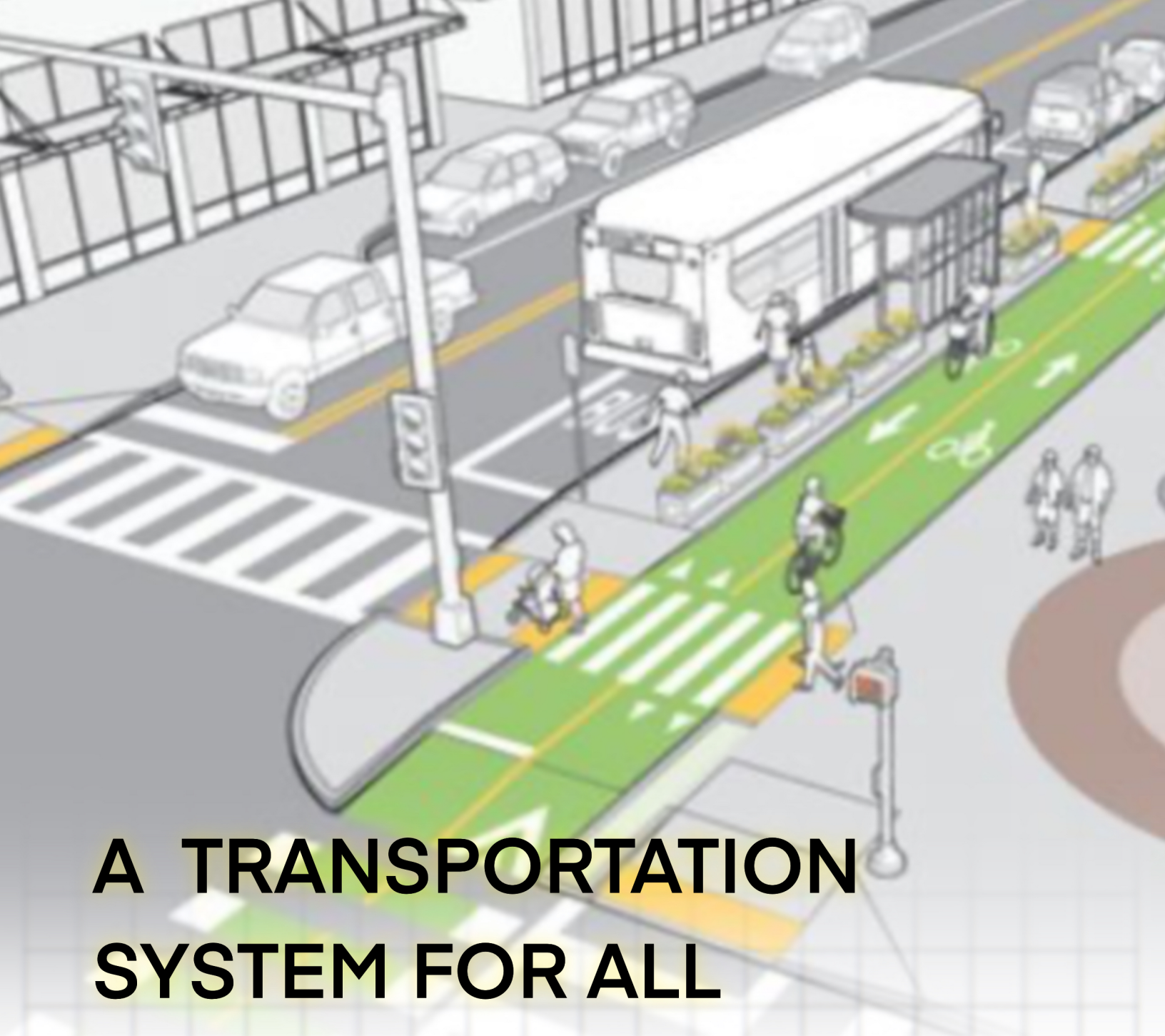


MOVING GUYANA FORWARD: TRANSFORMING GUYANA'S TRANSPORTATION NETWORK

Transportation in Guyana has long been ignored, leaving citizens to suffer the consequences of poor planning, high road mortality, and high transportation costs.

With Guyana so poised for massive development, there is an urgent need for development of the transportation sector - one of the pillars to support growth and expansion. The Alliance For Change (AFC) is proposing bold, transformative strategies to revolutionise the movement of people and goods, and bring Guyana's transportation sector into the 21st century. Our transportation plan outlines measures to improve ease and efficiency of transportation within the short-term (5 years), medium-term (10 years), and long-term (20 years).

A TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM FOR ALL

Transportation in Guyana is stuck at a standstill. Outdated infrastructure, poor planning, and a lack of data are gridlocking development.

The AFC's Moving Guyana Forward Transportation Plan will build an efficient, accessible transportation network for all Guyanese - linking communities, improving lives.

DATA-DRIVEN PLANNING

- Focus on data collection and predictive modelling for new projects

RELIABLE TRANSPORTATION

- Safe and reliable, public transportation options for all communities

NO MORE TRAFFIC

- Meaningful solutions to alleviate traffic woes; solve congestion

BETTER NEIGHBOURHOODS

- Rethink streets, neighbourhoods to be people-first; prioritise walkable spaces

SAFE ROADS

- Redesign roads to reduce accidents, prevent fatalities

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

- Long-term, environmentally friendly, responsible development



Phase 1:

The First 5 Years

MINISTRY OF TRANSPORTATION

- Projects driven by data, statistics, and proper planning

RELIABLE TRANSPORTATION

- Safe and efficient scheduled bus, tram, water taxi, and ferry services.

DYNAMIC DATA & REPORTING

- Continuous monitoring and statistical analysis to ensure maintained efficiency in transportation

SAFE STREETS

- Streets designed to prioritise people, safety and efficiency

TRANSIT-FIRST PLANNING

- Smart neighbourhoods built with connectivity in mind to ease traffic



Phase 2:

6-10 Years: Continued Buildout

- **National Rail Link:** Connect every Administrative Regional capital through a National Rail Link to move passengers and freight
- **Highway Upgrades:** Bringing our highways to international standards, improving safety and reducing commute times
- **Transport and Logistics Hubs:** Transform Lethem, Linden, and New Amsterdam into freight and logistics rail hubs
- **River Links:** Expand water transport services to improve connection to riverine communities

LONG-RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN (LRTP)



11-20 Years

- **Complete Streets:** Safe, comfortable, walkable streets with zero road-user fatalities
- **Zero Emissions Transportation:** Green, clean, sustainable transportation for all of Guyana
- **Air-Land Linkages:** Bridging air travel with transportation links to the rest of the country
- **Mobility Hubs Projects:** Anchoring communities, improving connectivity, fostering social cohesion
