Guyana's education system faces major challenges, including low pass rates in key examinations and disparities based on geography, socio-economic status, ethnicity, and class. To address these issues and align with global best practices, the Alliance For Change (AFC) proposes a comprehensive education strategy. This strategy aims to develop innovative thinking and adaptability among students, preparing them to thrive in a rapidly changing world influenced by technological advancements, climate change, and other unforeseen factors. The plan outlines short-term (5 years), medium-term (10 years), and longterm (20 years) objectives to transform Guyana's education landscape.
